



Admissions Placement Exam

General Information:

The Admissions Placement Exam (APE) is used in determining your admissions status. You cannot fail the exam; however, your scores are used to determine what remedial course(s) you may need.

All exams are taken in Building A. Please report to the Admissions Office 10-15 minutes prior to testing time. The average time required to complete all sections of the examination is 2½ hours. There is no cost for the APE; however, there is a \$20 application fee payable prior to taking the entrance exam.

NOTE: Stop by or call the Admissions Office (229-225-5060) to reserve your seat. Picture ID is required at the time you take the examination. Applicants are allowed one (1) retest per section. There will be a \$15 per section retest fee!
